Attention Dairyman:

What is one of the biggest problems you face during the hot summer months?

Depressed Intakes !!

There are 2 causes of depressed summer intakes:

- 1. Hot Weather More than a century ago, Mark Twain said "Everybody talks about the weather, but nobody does anything about it". He's still right. Cattle don't eat as much when the weather is hot, and we still can't do anything about the weather.
- 2. Secondary Fermentation Exposing silage to air allows bacteria and mold organisms to begin fermentation all over again. Mixing other "good" ingredients with it just gives the microorganisms more nutrients to feed off.
